Midway Borough Guidelines for Sanitation Pick-Up

GARBAGE PICK UP IS EVERY WEDNESDAY. If a major holiday falls on Wednesday, pick up will be one day earlier on Tuesday

- All garbage must be bagged or placed in containers. The maximum weight per bag or container is 30 pounds.
- There is a limit of either 4 trash cans or 8 bags (30 pound/each) per week.
- All garbage should be placed at the curb before 4:00 a.m. the morning of pick up.
- There is no guarantee that garbage will be picked up at the same time each week.
- Do not put garbage out more than 12 hours prior to pick up.
- All garbage must be generated on the property. No garbage from any outside source is permitted to be placed with the property owner's garbage.

BULK TAGS REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS BUT NOT LIMITED TO THIS LIST:

Bulk Tags are \$20 each item. You can obtain a Bulk Tag from the Borough Office. If there is no visible Bulk Tag, the item will not be picked up.

YARD WASTE:

- GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES and GARDEN CLIPPINGS Must be placed in garbage bags not exceeding 30 pounds and there is a 4 bag a week limit.
- TREE LIMBS Must be no larger than 3 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length. Must be bundled in less than 2 feet in diameter and not to exceed 30 pounds.
- CHRISTMAS TREES Will be collected during the month of January.
